We follow with our historic production of Robeson. Here we engage the full ballet and chorus to create the atmosphere in which the world's most complete man, thrived. Paul Robeson was concerned about all human beings and traveled to stand with all of those persecuted for their beliefs. The massive work includes the spirituals and work, art, and folk songs, Robeson used as his platform for justice.

Then we have to return to Dubois and Booker t. Washington who fought on the approach forward , respecting each other's strategic plan to move and progress as a nation.

James Baldwin will suppose the commentary on the murders of three Black men by police in the quest against crime? What would he say, as we look at these artistic renderings, of murder in the community.
